### General Statement on Support for Open VME Version 5

#### Applies to the UK and Worldwide

OpenVME version 5 was introduced in March 2003 and this announcement follows Fujitsu's policy of supporting OpenVME versions for a period of 5 years after General Release.

**This Marketing Bulletin formally confirms the withdrawal of support for OpenVME version 5 at the end of March 2008 on all platforms and in all territories. Support for previous versions of OpenVME and all versions of VME (SV294) has already been withdrawn.**

Fujitsu is committed to support VME until at least 2020 and OpenVME versions 6 and 7 (due for release in August 2007) are direct replacement upgrades for OpenVME version 5.

**Trimetra** NOVA and *mini*NOVA customers are encouraged to upgrade to the latest release of OpenVME to take advantage of the latest features and benefits of OpenVME. Customers planning to move to **super**NOVA are reminded that they must upgrade to OpenVME version 6, or later, prior to the move

#### Alternative Products

OpenVME versions 6 and 7 are direct replacement upgrades for OpenVME version 5. Fujitsu provides a range of professional services to upgrade customers systems to the latest version of OpenVME.
