### **General Statement on Support of SUN StorageTek Software Product Versions**

**Applies to the UK and Worldwide**

SUN has announced withdrawal of certain versions of ACSLS and LibAttach software from sale. Subsequently, they have also announced withdrawal of support for these product versions. Fujitsu uses these products for the control of SUN StorageTek tape libraries connected to VME.

**This Marketing Bulletin formally confirms the Withdrawal of Support Services for the SUN StorageTek product versions shown in the table below, with effect from the dates shown. This withdrawal applies to all territories.**

## **Alternative Products**

ACSLs version 7.2 is available for both SPARC (Sun Blade 150) and x64 (Sun Fire X2100) servers. Customers should note that Sun Blade 150 systems will also need to be upgraded to Solaris 10 and that a minimum of 512Mb of main store is required.

LibAttach version 1.4.2 replaces the withdrawn item.

Customers are urged to upgrade to the latest supported software versions, and should contact their Fujitsu sales representative to discuss further.
